BG42 RESPONDED TO 162 N MAIN ST FOR AN ASSAULT REPORT THAT OCCURED AT 238 N. MAIN ST. BG42 SPOKE WITH BAR MANAGER ANDREW GIBSON, WHO STATED THAT BAR EMPLOYEE CRISTIAN ROSALES WAS ASSAULTED BY A MALE INSIDE 238 N. MAIN ST.

On July 29, 2019 at approximately 2300 hours, Ptl. Damschroder and I responded to Uptown/Downtown bar, 162 North Main Street for an assault report. I spoke with bar manager ANDREW GIBSON. GIBSON stated CRISTIAN ROSALES, one of the bouncers of Liquid Bar, 238 North Main Street, was assaulted by a male he removed from the bar. GIBSON stated that when the male was near the rear door, he took a beer bottle and threw it as ROSALES striking him in the head.

ROSALES was with GIBSON as he was talking to me. I asked ROSALES if he had any injuries from the beer bottle and he said he had a small bump and bruise slightly above his forehead. ROSALES said he did not need medical attention. I looked at where ROSALES pointed and it was not visible enough to show up in a photo. I asked ROSALES to tell me what happened.

He stated the male was causing problems at the Tiki bar and was yelling at the bar tenders that he wanted to be served. ROSALES said he approached the male and told him to be patient because the bar was full and the bartenders were busy. ROSALES said the male started to argue with him and stated to him, "Get the fuck away from me." ROSALES stated at that time, he asked the male to exit the bar because he was no longer welcome in the establishment. ROSALES said he told the male numerous times to leave the bar and the male refused to leave. ROSALES said when additional bar staff arrived to help ROSALES remove the male from the bar, a friend of the male began to push the male towards the exit. ROSALES said before the male exited the bar, he grabbed a beer bottle that his friend was holding. ROSALES said the employee working at the door tried to grab the bottle before the male exited the bar but did not get it. ROSALES said the male then threw the bottle at him and it struck him in the head and knocked his baseball cap off.

Once the male left the bar, ROSALES said bar staff rushed to the front door to make sure the male was not going to try to enter the bar through the front door. ROSALES said the male did attempt to enter the bar again from the front door but bar staff did not allow him back inside. ROSALES said the male's friend was holding him back as the male yelled threats to ROSALES. ROSALES advised the male said he was going to stab and kill ROSALES and the other member of bar staff. ROSALES said the male stated he would stab anyone in the neck who touched him.

GIBSON stated to me that the male who threw the bottle at ROSALES is MICHAEL LASTER. I asked GIBSON how he knows the male involved is LASTER. He said that he recognized him as being a player on the BGSU men's basketball team and other subjects who watched the video recognized him as a BGSU basketball player. GIBSON had the BGSU athletics website on his laptop computer as I was talking to him. He showed me a picture of LASTER on the BGSU website, which did appear to be the male in the video who threw the bottle at ROSALES.

I obtained written statements from GIBSON, ROSALES and LEE HART. HART had helped ROSALES get LASTER out of the bar and witnessed him throw the bottle at ROSALES. GIBSON had a copy of the video ready for me to take. I advised GIBSON and ROSALES I would be in contact with them.

On station, I watched the videos from the bar. In the video looking over the Tiki bar, LASTER can be seen standing at the bar and is approached by ROSALES. ROSALES is talking to LASTER several minutes, which is when ROSALES said he asked LASTER to leave the bar several times and LASTER refused to leave. Eventually, LASTER leaves the bar with several bar staff employees around him. The video ends with LASTER, ROSALES and HART walking towards the rear Tiki bar door. The Tiki backdoor video shows LASTER come into view and he can be seen taking a beer from the hand of another male. The male he took the beer from appears to be trying to get LASTER out of the bar. Seconds after LASTER walks out the back door, the bottle can be seen flying inside and

Affiant says that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant committed an offense, based upon the summary of the facts below.

To wit: On July 28th, 2019 at 0039 hours at Liquid bar in Bowling Green, Ohio. MICHAEL LASTER was sitting at the Tiki Bar causing a problem with bar staff. He was asked to leave several times by the staff and refused to leave. After numerous requests to leave the bar, LASTER eventually began to exit out the rear door of the Tiki Bar. As he was leaving, he grabbed a glass beer bottle and threw it at CRISTIAN ROSALES, a bar staff member, hitting him on the left side of his forehead with the beer bottle. LASTER was cited with assault and criminal trespass.

Saturday night into Sunday Morning the 28th of July my security manager informed me that an altercation had taken place at our Tiki bar rear entrance. Cristian Rosales informed me that an individual had thrown a beer bottle and struck him in the head at roughly 12:30 am after asking the individual to leave. At the end of the shift I asked information about the incident. Around 1pm Sunday afternoon one of my other floor staff employees, Jarrod Smith, had informed me that the individual who threw the bottle was Michael Laster of the Men's Basketball team. After being informed of that, I reviewed the footage of the incident and compared his picture from the athletics web site to the individual. I then asked Cristian to confirm his identity by showing him the video as well as his roster picture. He said he recognized him and agreed that Laster was the individual that threw the bottle at his head on the back patio.

My first encounter with the suspect, Michael Laster was when I walked behind the tiki bar to check on the bartenders. The suspect was standing to the left of the entry way to behind the bar. The suspect grabbed my attention by yelling that he wanted to be served. I let him know to be patient because the bar was full of people and the bartenders were busy. The suspect started to argue with me and became aggressive as he told me to "get the fuck away from him." At this point, I asked the suspect to exit the bar because he was no longer welcome in our bar. The suspect made no effort to leave. I asked him multiple times over the next two minutes to exit the bar, and he again made no effort to exit. As soon as the rest of the floor staff arrived to help me, his friend that was with him started to push him towards the exit. Before exiting, the suspect grabbed a beer bottle that his friend was holding. The door guy made an attempt to grab the bottle before it left the property. The suspect took possession of the beer bottle and threw the bottle at my direction. -

The bottle struck my head and knocked off my baseball cap. At this point, the suspect and his friend were out of the bar. My staff and I rushed to the front door of Liquid to make sure the suspect did not re-enter. The suspect made an attempt to enter, but the staff did not allow him.

The suspect's friend was holding him back while he continued to make threats at me. He said he was going to kill, as well as stab myself and my staff. The suspect also made threats upon his exit of the bar.

The suspect said he would stab in the neck anybody that touches him. There were no more altercations after the denied entry of the suspect.

I obtained a small bruise on my head from the bottle, but did not need medical attention.
